When God is Pleased to Provide

Psalm 26

'...When we walk in integrity God's ears are wide open...'

1 REVIEW THE SERMON

LEADER NOTES: Encourage your members to pull out their notes and review the main points of the sermon. (9-12 mins)

Reread Psalm 26

As Christians what do we see in the text that informs us that we do not have to live as losers to sin?

What are the hallmarks of integrity?

What is the psalmist expectant outcome because he is living in integrity?

2 ASSESS YOUR LIFE

LEADER NOTES: Evaluate the condition of your lives in relation to the truth from God's Word. Encourage heart examination. (12-15 mins)

Are you living your life in a manner that you can confidently approach God as the psalmist did? Have you ever needed to approach God in this way ?

Do you know at the very core, that you can have victory, that you can live with integrity? What are some of the things that can hinder your celebration of victory?

Can you think of some victories that you can share that characterize your life?

3 APPLY THE TRUTH

LEADER NOTES: Create a list of ways to close the gap between your lives and the truth of the Bible. Be practical and intentional. (12-15 mins)

How does walking in integrity increase confidence?

How does acknowledging the faithful love of God guard us from self righteousness?

What does integrity look like?

4 COMMIT THIS WEEK

LEADER NOTES: Call your small group members to make a commitment and get the group working together to follow-up with each other. (9-12)

Will you live with expectant integrity this week, just as the psalmist proclaimed (vs 9-12)?
