John 13:34-35

'...Love proves your life has been changed from above...it is the normal extension of a life transformed by divine

1 REVIEW THE SERMON

LEADER NOTES: Encourage your members to pull out their notes and review the main points of the sermon. (9-12 mins)

Based on Jesus criteria how will we be recognized as His disciples?

What are some expressions of loving one another we can practice? (Romans 12:10; Galatians 5:13; Ephesians 4:2-3; Hebrews 10:24-25)

2 ASSESS YOUR LIFE

LEADER NOTES: Evaluate the condition of your lives in relation to the truth from God's Word. Encourage heart examination. (12-15 mins)

What affects our ability to love one another?

What are some challenges you face to loving one another?

Is there evidence in your relationships that you are a disciple of Jesus?

3 APPLY THE TRUTH

LEADER NOTES: Create a list of ways to close the gap between your lives and the truth of the Bible. Be practical and intentional. (12-15 mins)

What does it take to love the way Jesus calls us to love?

What is true love? (1 John 4:10) Why is propitiation requisite to true love?

If all worldly 'love' is at best a shadow of this love, what may the reaction be to true pure love?

4 COMMIT THIS WEEK

LEADER NOTES: Call your small group members to make a commitment and get the group working together to follow-up with each other. (9-12)

Will you decide (with your God given by grace ability) to live out your love for one another?

How can we hold ourselves and one another accountable in this?
