EADER NOTES: Evaluate the condition of your lives in relation to the truth from God's Word. Encourage heart examination, (12-15 mins)

What are your spiritual gifts? If you aren't sure, how might you identify your gifts?

Do you find it difficult to do something for someone else when you know that nobody will appreciate it? If so, why do you think that is?



APPLY THE TRUTH

LEADER NOTES: Create a list of ways to close the gap between your lives and the truth of the Bible. Be practical and intentional. (12-15 mins)

Are you willing to roll up your sleeves and serve others in practical ways, even when you know that you will not receive any recognition for doing so? Are you willing to do the jobs nobody else wants to do? Why or why not?

What gifts, talents, opportunities and resources has God given you? How might you use them to serve and benefit others?

What is your biggest barrier to humbly serving others? How might that barrier be overcome?



In what practical ways will you love and serve others this week? How will you plan to make it happen?
