

# PREACHING CURRICULUM

## Christ is Victor! Revelation 5

**"Worthy is the Lamb who was slain,  
to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might  
and honor and glory and blessing!"**

### 1 REVIEW THE SERMON

**LEADER NOTES:** Encourage your members to pull out their notes and review the main points of the sermon. (9-12 mins)

**Read Revelation 5:1-14.** What is the significance of the scroll? Why is it important that it was written on both the front and back? What do the seven seals represent?

Who is the Lamb? What names and descriptions are given of Him in verses 5 and 6? What are the significance of each of them?

Why is the Lamb the only one in all of heaven and earth who is worthy to open the scroll and to look at its contents? What does the act of opening the scroll represent?

What honour does the Lamb receive from the hosts of heaven in this passage? How does the honour given to the Lamb compare to that which is given to God in Chapter 4 (see especially 4:9-11)?

What are we to conclude about the identity of the Lamb from the fact that He receives the same honour, glory, and worship that God receives in this passage?

### 2 ASSESS YOUR LIFE

**LEADER NOTES:** Evaluate the condition of your lives in relation to the truth from God's Word. Encourage heart examination. (12-15 mins)

When have you had to wait upon God? What was the result?

Is it possible to discover the revelation of God on our own, apart from Jesus? Why or why not?

How highly do you honour Jesus? Based on today's passage, how highly *should we honour Jesus*?

### 3 APPLY THE TRUTH

**LEADER NOTES:** Create a list of ways to close the gap between your lives and the truth of the Bible. Be practical and intentional. (12-15 mins)

Will worship in heaven ever become boring? How is it possible to worship forever without getting tired of it?

Why is Jesus worthy of our honour and worship? What accomplishments of His are celebrated in this passage?

What does it mean to be made a kingdom of priests (see 5:10)? Why is that such good news for us?

### 4 COMMIT THIS WEEK

**LEADER NOTES:** Call your small group members to make a commitment and get the group working together to follow-up with each other. (9-12)

How might the words of Revelation 5 fuel your worship of Jesus this week?
