APPLY THE TRUTH A proper view of authority and fear of the Lord were clearly lacking in the people of God, and so this was reflective in their worship. What are some ways that a proper view of authority and fear of the Lord have shaped your worship? How should this changed your posture when you come to church? Our natural tendency as humans is to get away with the minimal amount of effort required and still get the job done. This was true of God's people in this passage with regards to their worship and is still true for us today. How do we as followers of Christ guard against such stinking thinking in our worship? (Roman 12:1) You may say something like 'I just don't feel like singing, I worship by listening to the sermon'. Or 'the style doesn't match my preferences, so I don't sing'. How do we shut down this type of profane worship in the church?
